## Essential Eligibility Requirements for Camp Admission:

- 1. Camper must be of appropriate age or ability for session requested.
- 2. Camper must have a developmental, physical or other health-impaired disability identified by physician or medical provider.
- 3. Camper must have the ability to adapt to a group living routine at camp within 24 hours of check-in, with minimal disruption to the group living environment. This includes, but is not limited to, non-compliance of instructions from DOC staff or causing disruption to other campers' experiences.
  - Staff and campers sleep in the same room. Campers are expected to have minimal disruptions during quiet hours of overnight sleep and rest time.
- 4. Our DOC program is designed to meet the needs of campers based on a 3:1 or better camper to counselor ratio. Campers must be successful in the 3:1 ratio. **DOC is not staffed to offer 1:1 assistance/supervision in group settings at this time.** If you feel that your camper would be successful but would not fit into our current camper-to-staff ratio, please contact us to discuss additional possibilities.
- 5. Camper must not aggressively abuse him/herself or others. Any potentially aggressive behaviors must be able to be managed in a recreational environment within a 3:1 ratio. Camper must be able to socially and emotionally participate with other children, and their behavior disorders or mental health conditions must not pose serious risk or harm to themselves, other campers, or to staff.
- 6. Camp staff review Individual Education Plans that are active and initiated by school districts. These reviews help staff set goals/objectives and help to communicate other behavioral, physical, social issues or concerns so that the campers can be supported for the greatest camper success.
- 7. Camper must not have a medical condition that requires a 1:1 ratio (24/7). Additionally, the camper must not pose a substantial risk or likelihood for complication or injury that would require specialized medical treatment.
- 8. Camper must have the ability to eat or drink amounts adequate for nutritional support and camper must be agreeable to accept personal medications from camp medical personnel.
